Owen A. Barfield

Owen A. Barfield is the only grandchild of the "First and Last Inkleling" Owen Barfield (1898 – 1997). He was 28 when his Grandfather passed away, and became the trustee of the Owen Barfield Literary Estate in 2006. The Barfield Press was started the publishing arm of the Literary Estate. A new collection of Barfield essays and a new illustrated edition of *The Silver Trumpet* are due out this year, with more to come.

Research material is in the archive of the Owen Barfield Papers at the Bodleian Library, University of Oxford (Owen's permission needed to view). Additional Barfield archival papers are also available in the Wade Collection, Wheaton IL and at Azusa Pacific University Library, near Los Angeles USA.
